Question #27, version A

All of the following bones are part of the axial skeleton EXCEPT:

- A. **Clavicle – answer in key**
- B. Ilium
- C. Cervical vertebrae
- D. Ethmoid
- E. Two of the above – **my answer**

Answer states that the correct answer is A – Clavicle but I think the correct answer should be E- Two of the above because the ilium and the clavicle are part of the appendicular skeleton and therefore not part of the axial skeleton. I learned this in our text on Table 7.1 (page 172) and on Figure 7.1 (page 173).
